SCHEDULE YOUR VACCINATION

WITH HARRIS COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH

Harris County Public Health (HCPH) makes it easy for county residents to get a FREE COVID-19 vaccination. Register today!

- Vaccines are free.
- People 16 years or older are eligible for the Moderna and Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
- People 12 years or older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine.
- Proof of citizenship, residence, or insurance is not required.

Residents will be contacted and provided an opportunity to make an appointment.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Only individuals with scheduled appointments will be vaccinated.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time.
- Persons to be vaccinated are encouraged to wear short sleeved shirts.
- Facemasks are required on site.

Some COVID-19 vaccines require two shots administered several weeks apart. After receiving your first shot, you will be contacted to schedule an appointment for your second shot. Those who show up without an appointment at an HCPH vaccination site will be turned away.

Harris County Public Health has created an efficient, fair, and equitable distribution process for vaccines. As HCPH receives shipments of vaccines, individuals will be selected from the waitlist based on a randomized process, including individuals in phase 1A, 1B, 1C, and older individuals prioritized over those younger.

The Texas Department of State Health Services has prioritized vaccine distribution to residents in categories 1A, 1B, and 1C. Adults who are not included in Phases 1A, 1B, or 1C are still eligible for vaccination and may register for the waitlist.

WHO IS INCLUDED IN PHASES 1A, 1B, AND 1C?

- Frontline Health Workers
- Long-term Care Facility Residents
- Persons 50 Years or Older
- Persons 16 Years or Older with Chronic Medical Conditions at Increased Risk of Severe Illness
- Education and Child Care Workers, Including Teachers, Staff, and Bus Drivers
