Vaccination Update

Pfizer Vaccine Now Available to Children Ages 12–15

Following Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations, Harris County Public Health (HCPH) announces that children ages 12–15 are now eligible to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine at NRG Park.

THREE WAYS TO GET KIDS VACCINATED:

Parents can pre-register their children to get the vaccine by visiting [ReadyHarris.org](https://www.ReadyHarris.org).

Appointments can be made by calling the HCPH Vaccine Center at (832) 927-8787.

3

Parents can drive up without an appointment to the vaccination site at NRG Park, open daily from 12 p.m.–9 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE BEFORE VACCINATION:

- Parents or guardians can choose the NRG Park location when they enter their child's date of birth when they register online.
- Parents or guardians who do not accompany their child need to sign a parental consent form to authorize their children to get the vaccine.
- If parents go to the vaccination site without an appointment, the parental consent form will be provided on site.
- Vaccines are free.
- Proof of citizenship, residence, or insurance is not required.
- Persons to be vaccinated are encouraged to wear short sleeved shirts.
- Facemasks are required on site.
